- •Your accommodation is 4* heritage Fort Chanwa, owned and lovingly renovated by Maharaj Dalip Singh, younger brother of former Maharaja of Jodhpur, H.H Umaid Singh.
- •Heritage Hotel Fort Chanwa of Luni is an exceptional example of elegance and symmetry in Indian architecture of the last century. The entire fortress is carved out of the famous red sandstone of Jodhpur and with its ornately carved lattice work friezes and intricate "Jharokas", it exquisitely captures the romance and grace of a bygone age.
- •The fort is composed of a lyrical complex of courtyards towers, water, wheels, stables, passages and unexpected stairways to secret pavilions and panoramic roof tops spanning the village below and the Thar horizon beyond.
- •The rooms are surrounded by beautiful gardens and spaces in which to practise music, dance and yoga in peace.











Heritage Tourism and Sightseeing














- Jodhpur Sightseeing will include visits to Mehrangarh Fort, Jaswant Thada, Clock Tower and the Old City (also known as The Blue City)

- A great opportunity to see a variety of acts over a week, making this the best music festival in India!
















Jodhpur, the Blue City



Meet Our Gurus: Instrumental






Imran Khan is a prolific sitarist and composer in his own right. It could be said that Imran has music in his blood. Literally.
